November 3, 2008

The meeting was called to order by president Al Driver at 7:15 PM.

ATTENDANCE- A motion was made by Dave Dickinson and seconded by Tom Varner to have attendance taken by sign-in rather than roll-call. The motion passed.

TREASURER'S REPORT-(see hard copy); Tom Varner reported that October was mostly a "break even" month. There is still some ad money to be collected, and John Mosher reported that he still has some show shirt money.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS-The organization has some serious money issues...there is currently no UD chairperson. Bill Montgomery is generously still keeping that fundraiser afloat. He is short 2-4 captains and many workers. We may have to go to a smaller stand, which makes less money and isn't as consistent as our bigger stand. This is an \$8,000 fundraiser.

Bob Hess is stepping down as Dragon's Chair and we need a chairperson by January at the latest. We are losing many Senior parent captains after this season. This is a \$41,000 fundraiser!! If we take a year off we will not get our spot back.

There is no Calendar Chair as of yet.

NEW BUSINESS-Erica Cinibulk is stepping down as SCRIP Chair in May. We need someone to take over and start shadowing immediately.
